WE WANT TO RECOGNIZE one of our NVBA members, who has left our area and is greatly missed, not only as a pleasant opponent at the bridge tables, but for the volunteer work that he did for years. Beginning in the Fall of 1972 Mick Staps, Jim Dresser, John White and Charles (Chas) Fain entered a Round Robin tournament. With about 50 points total on the team, of the 27 teams in the Round Robin, they were seeded 27th. They lost to Jim Wood, Fred Karpin, Steve Parker and others. Somehow they won the last match against the #4 seed, and, thus encouraged, were hooked on bridge.

Chas Fain found satisfaction volunteering at St. Elizabeth's (St. E's) Hospital playing bridge with the patients as part of St. E's patient recreational therapy in their monthly game for over 38 years. Chas not only played, but he set up a bank account for the game, wrote monthly checks for refreshments and bridge supplies, and submitted annual statements to the

ACBL, NVBA and the Hospital. Playing mostly in local games and tournaments, Chas had over 800 master points when he finally got his gold points to make Life Master (LM). So he became a Bronze LM at the same time and has gone on to win many more points. Chas has moved to Florida to be near his daughter and is enjoying the duplicate games there.

The Jack of Hearts

AT THE NATIONALS in Louisville this year, I pondered a conundrum. When it comes to pronunciation, who determines correctness? Let's say your name is Wojciechowski. Someone asks you how you pronounce it and you say Smith. Who can argue? It's your name. OK, let's take a more realistic example. Last summer the Nationals were in New Orleans in a state we call Loo-weezie-anna. But ask the natives and they'll tell you it's Loo-zee-anna. Wouldn't it be presumptuous for us to tell them they're wrong? So how do you pronounce Louisville? The one thing we know for sure is that it's not Looey-ville. To begin with, nobody who lives there (or maybe anywhere in the South) says "ville". It's more like "vul", if that. It

pretty much gets swallowed. So depending on who you talk to, you'll get Looa-vul, Loo-vul, or even Luh-vul. Even they can't agree on what's right.

At first glance, Louisville might have been the least attractive of this year's Nationals. As it turns out, it was a pleasant surprise. Good playing conditions, good restaurants, friendly people, and we missed most of the rain that caused the Ohio River to overflow its banks and submerge River Rd. adjacent to the host Galt House. What's more it may be the only NABC anyone can afford to go to this year. As I write this, airfare from DC to Toronto is \$650. We can only imagine what it will be to Seattle. Platinum points may be more expensive from now on. Besides, if you didn't go to Louisville, you may never know what a Hot Brown is. I still don't know, but it was served as the hospitality item one night and was pretty tasty. Early in the week I asked a local who informed me that its nickname was Heart Attack On a Bun. (Editor's note: It can be served as a open-faced sandwich or a casserole. See recipe following this article.)

Louisville also had the distinction of being the least disappointing NABC in a while. The final table count of 9,547 was almost spot on pre-tournament estimates. More disappointing was the success for the NVBA on the field of battle. Our highest finish was turned in by Deb Dhar, who was 9th in the Red Ribbon as well as hitting the board in the Flight B NAP. Others with National overalls were Jeff Roman with three, Mike Cappelletti and Rusty Krauss with two, and Gil Cohen, Alan Schwartz, John Miller, and Robbie Hopkins with one each. Regional winners included Sumner Steinfeldt (Compact KO and Open Pairs), John Miller, Robbie Hopkins, and Jay Kelkar (Compact KO), Alan Schwartz (Fast Pairs), and Mike Cappelletti (Senior Swiss). Maybe we'll do better in Toe-ron-toe. At least we'll agree on how to pronounce it.

Editor's note re the "Hot Brown":

The History of The Brown Hotel's "Hot Brown"

With so much to boast – award-winning dining, breathtaking turn-of-the-century architecture, and attentive, caring service – some may wonder, "Why the Hot Brown?"

Here is the history behind this now legendary dish...

In the 1920's, The Brown Hotel drew over 1,200 guests each evening for its dinner dance. In the wee hours of the morning, the guests would grow tired of dancing and retire to the restaurant for a bite to eat. Diners were growing rapidly bored with the traditional ham and eggs, so Chef Fred Schmidt set out to create something new to tempt his guests' palates. His unique creation was an open-faced turkey sandwich with bacon and a delicate Mornay sauce. Exemplifying the hotel's unending dedication to serving their guests, The Hot Brown was born!

The Legendary Hot Brown Recipe

Ingredients (Makes Two Hot Browns):

- 2 oz. Whole Butter
- 2 oz. All Purpose Flour
- 1 Qt. Heavy Cream
- 1/2 Cup Pecorino Romano Cheese, Plus 1 Tablespoon for Garnish
- Salt & Pepper to Taste
- 14 oz. Sliced Roasted Turkey Breast
- 2 Slices of Texas Toast (Crust Trimmed)
- 4 slices of Crispy Bacon
- 2 Roma Tomatoes, Sliced in Half
- · Paprika, Parsley

In a two-quart saucepan, melt butter and slowly whisk in flour until combined and forms a thick paste (roux). Continue to cook roux for two minutes over medium-low heat, stirring frequently. Whisk whipping cream into the roux and cook over medium heat until the cream begins to simmer, about 2-3 minutes. Remove sauce from heat and slowly whisk in Pecorino Romano cheese until the Mornay sauce is smooth. Add salt and pepper to taste.

For each Hot Brown, place one slice of toast in an oven safe dish and cover with 7 ounces of turkey. Take the two halves of Roma tomato and set them alongside the base of turkey and toast. Next, pour one half of the Mornay sauce to completely cover the dish. Sprinkle with additional Pecorino Romano cheese. Place entire dish under a broiler until cheese begins to brown and bubble. Remove from broiler, cross two pieces of crispy bacon on top, sprinkle with paprika and parsley, and serve immediately.





The District 6 North American Pairs Finals for all flights will be held on the weekend of September 24-25, 2011. The deadline for Pre-registration is September 17, but unregistered players will be accommodated, if possible. To pre-register, pairs should send a check made payable to District 6 in the amount of \$50.00, to cover two sessions of the event, to Barbara Doran, 1107 Dale Drive, Silver Spring MD 20910-1607. (As an option for Richmond area players, checks may be given to Paul Anderson (804-740-8666).) You and your partner must preregister as a pair and not as individuals. When pre-registering, please include names, ACBL numbers, and, for the 0-2000 and NLM flights, the site where you plan to play, and contact information (phone number/email).

The Open Flight Final is held at one location only and begins on March 24. It will be held at Newport Mill Middle School, 11311 Newport Mill Road, Kensington, MD 20895.

The 0-2000 Finals are split site and begin on March 24. The Northern site is Newport Mill Middle School,11311 Newport Mill Road, Kensington MD 20895. The Southern site will be in the Richmond area: at the Bridge Center, 1911 Bishop Road, Richmond, VA 23230-3101 on Saturday, March 24, and at the Tuckahoe Moose Lodge, 4366 Springfield Road, Glen Allen, VA 23060-4109 on Sunday, March 25.

The NLM Finals are also split site and are held one day only: Sunday, September 25. The Northern site event is being held

at Newport Mill Middle School, 11311 Newport Mill Road, Kensington, MD 20895. The Southern site is in the Richmond area at the Tuckahoe Moose Lodge, 4366 Springfield Road, Glen Allen, VA 23060-4109. (NLM eligible players may play in the Open or 0-2000 event on Saturday, March 24, and in the NLM event on Sunday if they don't qualify for the second day.) All games on Saturday, March 24, are at 12:00 noon and TBA. Sunday games are 11:00 AM and TBA in the North and 10:30 AM and TBA in the South.

The top three pairs in each flight will qualify for the National Finals. (See the Conditions of Contest for the formula for determining the order of split site finishes.) The National Finals will be held during the NABC in Memphis, TN. The National Final for the Open Flight will be held March 14-15, 2012. The National Finals for the 0-2000 and NLM Flights will be held March 24-25, 2012.
