THE **ANNUAL NVBA HOLIDAY PARTY**, which includes dinner and a bridge game, will be held on Thursday, December 14, 2017, at the **Knights of Columbus Hall**, 5115 N Little Falls Road Arlington, VA 22207. That week is a Sectional Tournament at Clubs (STaC) week, so the game will be held with STaC strats (0- 500/1500/1500+), and silver masterpoints will be awarded for placing in this game. As in the past, the holiday party is part catered and part pot-luck. The NVBA will provide main courses from an Italian restaurant, to include meat and vegetable lasagna and eggplant parmigiana. Everyone is asked to contribute a food dish: appetizer, salad, vegetable side dish or dessert. As we are not at Beth El this year, there are no restrictions on the food you can bring (as long as it's tasty!) We will have the usual sodas available and eggnog (spiked and unspiked). If you are unable to bring an item (or forget), you will be asked to donate \$5.00 toward party expenses. Dinner will begin at 5:30 pm.

From the President

What does it take to hold a Unit Game for Unit 218, the Northern Virginia Bridge Association? The NVBA is looking for a new location for its Thursday night Unit Game because of extra security costs imposed at Beth El, our home for many years, that would cause the game to operate in the red without a \$2 increase in entry fees. We need a space big enough to hold 55 tables. There needs to be room around each table, similar to the set-up we have had at Beth El or that we have at the Fairfax Elks Lodge for the

Sectionals. We don't have quite that many tables at the Knights of Columbus Hall (KoCH). Board member Francesca Mazarella indicated the following specifications: "81 sq ft per table including internal circulation. You need toilet facilities with at least 4 stalls. I would estimate 5,000 sq ft overall to include the Directors' area, hospitality tables, room for general circulation, a foyer, toilets, and storage space." Another smaller area for the 0-20 game is also necessary. We require parking for about 150 vehicles. A kitchen is nice but not required. Storage space for tables is mandatory; other materials, such as table mats, scoresheets, sets of cards, bid boxes, and bid box holders, can be schlepped to the game by various "volunteers." Speaking of volunteers, many places we might move to would not include putting up and taking down tables in the cost of the room rental, unlike our current arrangement at both KoCH and Beth El. Doing our own table set-up and take-down would require more volunteers.

Many places have been suggested, including various churches, fire halls and other venues where some daytime games are held. We have looked at them all. We thought we found an ideal spot located almost in the center of NVBA land. Alas, even though they indicated they might be able to accommodate us, they really were not interested, so we abandoned that possibility. Most places are not suitable because they don't have enough parking and/or room for 50+ tables, or are booked on Thursday nights already. Moving the Unit Game to another night isn't really feasible and has its own set of problems. Some of the places we checked out but that were not suitable for various reasons were:

As an experiment, we will be holding Thursday evening games during our February Sectional in the downstairs rooms at the Elks Lodge on Route 50.

If you know of another possible location for the Unit Game, PLEASE send your suggestion to a Board member or mention it to a Board member. We are trying to leave NO stone unturned.

It has been suggested we vote on whether to stay at KoCH or go back to Beth El. I hesitate to vote because I want to know what everyone thinks regarding these issues. A vote would only permit NVBA members to express themselves, but people play at the NVBA Unit Game who are not NVBA members. They have a right to be heard. So a survey will be presented in the not too distant future; stay tuned.

I have received emails from several people indicating that they would be willing to pay an additional fee every week to continue playing at Beth El. But the Board is concerned that an increase might drive other players away. We must maintain the current table count of 35 tables or more on average each week. If the table count were to drop off, the entry fee would need to go up even more to cover the rent and the security fee. Board member Kevin O'Brien reports the following recent table counts: For 37 playing dates so far in 2017 (we were closed July 6 for the District 6 Regional) Thursday evening NVBA attendance averages a hair over 34 tables each week. High was 50 tables June 2 (LM/NLM), low was 23.5 (Aug 10, Hunt Valley Regional). The last 8 weeks at Beth El (June and July, excluding LM/NLM game): 25.5, 34.5, 33.5, 34, 37.5, 34, 29.5, 28.5 (average = 32.125).First eight weeks at KoCH (Aug/Sept): 32.5, 23.5, 38.5, 40.5, 33, 32, 37, 34 (average = 33.875). That's an average of 7 additional players each week at KoCH.

We have moved the game to KoCH for the remainder of this year and for 2018. If we find another venue that is NOT KoCH or Beth El, we will move there, but right now that doesn't appear to be happening. There are FIVE dates in the rest of 2017 when we cannot play at KoCH. On FOUR of those dates—Oct. 5 and 19, Nov. 9 and Dec. 21—we will play at Beth El. On

those occasions, we will ask for a \$2 security charge on top of the usual game fee: that's \$12.00 for the open games, \$10.00 for the 199er game, \$7.00 for 5-20 players, \$2 for 0-5 players. This is an increase across the board for ALL players—the Board felt it was fairer to do this rather than having the higher level players pay more. At KoCH, the entry fees will remain \$10.00, \$8.00, \$5.00 and free, respectively. The fifth date when KoCH is unavailable is November 16. That's the Thursday of the Chesapeake Regional in Cambridge, Md, and the Board decided not to hold the game at Beth El that evening as the table count would not be sufficient to cover costs. There will also be no Unit Game November 23 (Thanksgiving).

We continue to look for volunteers for various jobs. We need people to do the snacks for Thursday nights, and also someone to make the coffee and set it up every week. Making the coffee is a simple job, and you receive a free play for doing it. The people who do the food receive a free play for themselves and their partner, and you are reimbursed for the cost of the food you buy/prepare/serve. Contact Sheila Ellis for Hospitality volunteering and Georgette Weiss for coffee setup. Their emails are on the website under NVBA Board on the left-hand side. Many hands make light work!

Toronto has everything our big cities have: skyscrapers, noise, and megatraffic, deep into the suburbs. Of course, it has a lake which might be a clue. And if you think regionals have become more attractive than nationals because they're less expensive, explain Atlanta's Labor Day regional being down 400 tables on the heels of drops in regionals in Hunt Valley and Bethesda.

Maybe Toronto deserves the credit because those who came had a great time. Lodging was expensive, but there were eats of every manner and price range within a short walk. And we're pleased to report that several NVBAers attended. Some even found success. Ai-Tai Lo started off making the semis of the GNT Open Flight and ended up winning the Roth Open Swiss. Hal Hindman and Kenton Schoen made the quarters in the Flight A GNT while Barry Ko was 8th in the Red Ribbon Pairs and Robbie Hopkins was 9th in the Mixed BAM. The NVBA had its biggest successes on the final weekend. Along with Ai-Tai's win, Ken Hopke and Elizabeth and Jerry Nolte were 3/4 in the 0-2500 Mini-Spingold while Cecily Kohler was 3/4 in the 0-6000 version. Jeffrey and Annie Schwartz along with David Fleischer were 8th in the 10K Mixed Swiss while Monique Smith was 10th. Others with national overalls were Jay Cherlow (Bruce LM Pairs), Ryan Connors (Mini-Spingold and Red Ribbon), and Stan Schenker (10K Pairs). Regional wins were recorded by Alex Prairie, Ron Kral, Ann Atcheson, George Parkins, and Marvin Raines. Not a bad haul for a foreign tournament, eh?
