From the President

One of the most frequent complaints NVBA Board members hear from players is that various local club directors are failing to submit masterpoint records to the ACBL on a timely basis. It's important to understand, however, that the NVBA has no control over the business practices of the directors in our unit.

Chapter 4 of the ACBL Handbook (http://web2.acbl.org/Handbook/handbook/ACBLHandbook.pdf) makes clear that local clubs are independent businesses whose games are sanctioned and controlled by the ACBL alone. Neither the Districts nor the Units in which club games take place have any direct or indirect

role in that relationship. Clubs are solely responsible for reporting the results of their games directly to the ACBL record-keepers. The Handbook says (Chapter 4, page 5) that each club "must submit a report for each month by the sixth of the following month for the players' masterpoints to be included in the next issue of the Bridge Bulletin."

As players ourselves, we certainly hope club directors will report masterpoint awards promptly, but we cannot take action as a Board against directors who miss the monthly deadline. Please note also that ACBL waits until February to finalize masterpoint counts in the Ace of Clubs and Mini-McKenney races so that all points won in a given year are correctly credited to that year's competition.

We thank all local players for their support of the game of bridge in Northern Virginia and appreciate your understanding that business practices of area Directors are not a matter for NVBA Board jurisdiction or intervention.

If you have an issue with a club director in Unit 218 not submitting your masterpoints at the conclusion of the month, you should first talk to the club director. If your requests or concerns are not addressed, then perhaps you should contact the ACBL at <u>clubs@acbl.org</u> to see if they can be of assistance to you. Ultimately, players can express their frustration by refusing to play at certain venues.

The NVBA is responsible for the Thursday night Unit Game. If you have questions, suggestions or concerns about that game, by all means contact a Board member.

Call for Volunteers!

<u>Unit Game Hospitality</u>: We need helpers! Many hands make light work. For providing food on Thursday evening, you are reimbursed up to \$70.00 for your purchases (keep the receipts!) and you receive two Unit game free plays. If we had 20 or so people who would help with this task, each individual would only have to take care of hospitality about once every 4-5 months, and NO one would get burned out! Hospitality coordinator Sheila Ellis can give you suggestions of what to bring as snacks. You can contact her at 703-354-6567 or speak to her when you see her playing bridge.

Partnership Help: We have two needs. One is for Guaranteed Partners (GP). A GP volunteers to play bridge with players who show up without a partner. He/she shows up about 30 minutes before the Unit Game starts. If assigned to play with a person, the GP plays for FREE that evening and receives a FREE play for future use. If the GP is not needed, they receive ONE free play and get to go home. Ideally, we need three GPs, for the 0-199, B/C and A/X games, but sometimes we have to make do with ONE person. When we only have ONE, it can be tricky, especially if there is someone who comes late to play, and the GP has already been assigned or gone home. So if you would be interested in doing this, please contact a Board member, a Director at the game, or the Partnership person—which brings me to our second need.

We need someone to coordinate the GP programs, which means taking calls and emails the week before the game and matching players up at the game. Leo Cardillo, our longtime Partnership Chair, has gone to Maine for the summer. Livingston Johnson is taking his place when he is in town this summer. It would be good to have a couple of other volunteers as backup. The person who does Partnerships for the evening receives a free play for her/his efforts. If you are interested in lending us a hand as a GP or Partnership Chair, talk to any Board member or a Director at the Unit Game. (Board members are: Marty Bley, Georgette Weiss, John Wertman, Ann Atcheson, Howard Stevens, Kevin O'Brien, Joe Hertz and David Lindley.)

Education and Practice Opportunities at the Unit Game for New Directors

The Unit Game can give inexperienced directors the opportunity to learn and see first-hand what goes into running a bridge game and/or club. If you have passed the Director's test and are interested in getting practice setting up a game and taking Director calls, talk to Jim Gerding, our Chief Director, about coming on Thursday to shadow the Directors at the game. You would shadow a current 0-20 game Director, a current 0-199 Director or the Head Director for the B/C game or the A/X game. If, after shadowing for a number of weeks, you would like to join the Director crew, we would be glad to have you start by joining the rotation for the 199er game. We need to enlarge our list of qualified directors. Doing so will give us more flexibil-

ity in using the directors we presently have, by giving current directors of various games more names to call on when they need a substitute director and by giving newly qualified directors experience, which can be hard to get.

As one of Angelo's many friends and bridge partners in northern Virginia, I just want to say that Angelo was a wonderful and kind man who everyone he played with and against at the bridge table thought the world of. We loved to hear his stories about playing with Al Roth and Bill Passell, the older brother of Mike Passell, currently the top masterpoint holder in the country, and how they taught Mike how to play. He also told us entertaining stories about playing golf with Joe Namath and Willie Mays, and about going into underground nuclear missile silos with armed guards. He chaired a Phoenix NABC, served on District Boards in New York and Arizona, and sat on many C&E Committees. He

won the Ace of Clubs race in his MP category, not only for our Unit but for all of District 6, all four years he lived in Virginia, and also many times in Arizona. He was a superb player with a strong sense of the ethics of the game, and he loved to explain to opponents how they could have played or defended a hand better after it was over. Many players have said how much they appreciated his hints and insights. In addition to all of his many regional wins over the years and success against top players in the country, he and I played in the Senior Olympics last September and won a Silver medal. He had a full life with no regrets and we all miss him very much. $-Lucy\ McCoy$
