Return of the In-Person Unit Game(!):

- To play in the NVBA-hosted games, you will need to provide proof of vaccination. You will only need to do this once as NVBA will keep a list of those vaccinated.
- Starting on Thursday, May 5 and continuing on alternating Thursdays, WBL will host the in-person games at the Ohr Kodesh Congregation.
- To play in the WBL-hosted games, you must be fully vaccinated (including a booster) for COVID-19
 unless you they have a documented medical exemption from vaccination. Documentary evidence of
 vaccination or medical exemption is required to enter the OKC building. For more information, please
