Please be on the lookout for a postal mailing from the NBVA Board and District 6 administrators regarding events in our area.



Return of the In-Person Unit Games:

- Members of NVBA and WBL are welcome to play in either the Thursday in-person Unit game or the Thursday online Unit game on BBO regardless of which club is hosting the game.
- Starting on Thursday, 4/28, NVBA will host in-person games at the Beth El Hebrew Congregation (3830 Seminary Rd, Alexandria, VA 22304) every other week. For these NVBA hosted in-person Unit games:
 - The games will start at 7:00 pm.
 - Initially, three sections of games will be scheduled Open, Flight B (under 2500), and 199ers, with a minimum of three tables required for a section to run.
 - The game fee is \$10.00 plus a security fee of \$2.00. Working to become a cash-free enterprise, NVBA plans to use Square - hardware for processing credit cards - for the purchase of all entry fees.
 - You must be vaccinated and be able to provide proof to both the NVBA and Beth El. There are no exceptions. You will only need to do this once for each organization.
 - The Beth El Mask Policy states masks are optional. However, if any player requests that all wear masks at their table, NVBA asks that the request be honored. Please bring a mask and mask-up if requested.
 - The main entrance doors are locked at all times. NVBA will have a person at the doors from
 6:30 pm until just before 7:00 pm to allow players to enter. Please try to arrive by 6:45 pm.
 - Beth El is a no smoking campus. Smoking is prohibited inside or out while on Beth El property.
- Starting on Thursday, 5/5, WBL will host the in-person games at the Ohr Kodesh Congregation (8300 Meadowbrook Lane, Chevy Chase, MD 20815) every other week. For these WBL hosted in-person Unit games:
 - The games will start at 7:30 pm.
 - You must be fully vaccinated (including a booster) unless you have a documented medical exemption. Documentary evidence of vaccination or medical exemption is required to enter the OKC building.
