### **Thursday Night Unit Games:**

 This Thursday, 5/26, NVBA will host the in-person Unit games with Open, Flight B (under 2000), and 199er sections at Beth El. As a reminder:



- Please <u>pre-register your COVID vaccination status</u> with NVBA. Otherwise, you need to show your COVID vaccination proof at the Beth El entrance. All players also need to sign the Beth El COVID waiver at the Beth El entrance. Once you do both items, you will be all set for future inperson NVBA unit games.
- Please bring a mask. The <u>Beth El Mask Policy</u> states masks are optional. However, if any player requests that all wear masks at their table, NVBA asks that the request be honored.
- Please bring your credit card. The game fee is \$10.00 plus a security fee of \$2.00. Working to become a cash-free enterprise, NVBA plans to use <u>Square hardware</u> for processing credit cards to handle the purchase of all entry fees.
- The games will start at 7:00PM, but please arrive by 6:55PM! Late arrivals will not be able to enter the building!
- NVBA will have a person at the door from 6:15PM until 6:55PM to allow players to enter. The main entrance doors will be locked at all other times, so there is no re-entry.
- Beth El is a no smoking campus. Smoking is prohibited inside or out while on Beth El property.
- For those looking for a partner for the NVBA-hosted in-person Unit Games, Marty Bley will be running a partnership desk. For more information, please visit **NVBA Partnership Desk** on the NVBA web site.
- For those who wish to play online this Thursday, WBL will be hosting the normal weekly joint Unit games on BBO with Open, Flight B (under 2500), 499er, 199er, and 0-20 sections. The 499er, 199er, and 0-20 games start promptly at 7:05PM. The other two Open and Flight B begin at 7:15PM.
- We will have the usual <u>6PM Jeff Roman Zoom Pregame Lesson</u> Jeff is continuing his series on 2/1 bidding and <u>Jeff Roman Zoom Postgame Discussion</u> before and after the online play.
