- Starting this week, there will be only one weekly NVBA Collective session available on BBO the standard Unit Games that we share with WBL on alternate Thursday nights. The Tuesday evening 199er game will no longer be available.

## **District Six and ACBL Events:**

- The Richmond Summer Sectional will be held this weekend (6/3 thru 6/5). See the tournament flyer **RBA June Sectional** for more information.
- District 6 Sectional Tournament at Clubs (STaC) are scheduled for Monday, 6/13, thru Sunday, 6/19. Check out the <u>ACBL Participating Clubs</u> list to see if your game is included.

- It is time to qualify to play in the North American Pairs (NAP). Regarding the NAP:
  - There are three flights to the event: Open, Flight B (under 2,500 masterpoints), and Flight C (non-life masters with less than 500 masterpoints).
  - The District 6 online Wednesday night games will all be NAP qualifying games. Games will be held twice a month during the summer 6/15, 6/29, 7/13, 7/27, 8/17, and 8/31 starting at 7:15PM.
  - The District 6 finals will be held online on 10/15 and 10/16. The National Finals will be at the New Orleans NABC in March 2023.
- On Friday, ACBL announced a 20% upgrade on overall awards when you play at in-person regional and sectional tournaments between 6/30/2022 and 6/28/2023.
