Baltimore Regional:

- The <u>Baltimore Regional</u> begins two weeks from today at the Baltimore Convention Center. Entry
 Express has been activated. This system works very well, we recommend that you prepurchase your

 Express Tournament List.
 - Click "Baltimore Summer Regional". Select events and then prepay.

- Stay at the beautiful Baltimore Inner Harbor Hilton! It connects to the Baltimore Convention Center via an enclosed, climate-controlled pedestrian walkway. The special room rate of \$126 at the Hilton is still available for online reservations! Go to https://book.passkey.com/e/50238921 and you will receive the special room rate if it is still available.

NVBA September Sensations Sectional:

- The NVBA will be holding its September Sensations Sectional from September 8-11.
