### **Thursday Night Unit Games:**

- Need practice of your in-person game before the First Baltimore Regional? Well, this Thursday, 8/18, NVBA will host an in-person North American Pairs Qualifier at Beth El. Games start promptly at 7:00PM. NAP Qualifier masterpoints are awarded in equal amounts of two colors red and black at an increased factor times the normal club game award.

- For those who wish to play online this Thursday, WBL will be hosting the weekly joint Unit games on BBO with Open, Flight B (under 2500), 499er, and 199er sections. The 499er and 199er games start promptly at 7:05PM. The other two Open and Flight B begin at 7:15PM.
- We will have the <u>Zoom Postgame Discussion</u> after the online play. Alan Schwartz will be this week's postgame host.

### **First Baltimore Regional:**

- The First Baltimore Regional begins one week from today and continues thru Sunday, 8/28 at the Baltimore Convention Center.
- As the tournament organizer, District 6 sent out an email last Friday evening to their members with an
  update. At the same time, they updated their <u>Baltimore Regional</u> Tournament webpage. Please read
  both for the latest valuable information concerning COVID-19 precautions, event locations, and lunch
  options.
- Considering the extent of COVID infections at the Providence NABC and current COVID levels in Baltimore City and nearby counties, the District 6 Board of Directors has reviewed the situation and established the following COVID-19 guidelines:
  - Mask wearing will be mandatory in the playing areas.
  - Masks may not be taken off in the playing areas for eating as it is not allowed in the playing areas.
  - You may remove your mask to take a sip of water or similar liquid and then put the mask back on.
  - The break periods during each session will provide time for players to go outside and remove their masks, if necessary.

- Wear a well-fitting N95 or KN95 mask. Cloth masks only will not be allowed.
- Also, in the past two weeks, a new and third way has been added to allow pre-registration proof of COVID-19 vaccination. Now players may email their vaccination data to <u>Vaccination Proof</u> if you wish to send it to a NVBA email address monitored by the Tournament Chair and the Safety Chair.
- For this tournament, **Entry Express** has been activated. Entry Express is ACBL's new portal for tournaments. You are able to view tournament details and buy event entries in advance. Check it out by:

- New and Intermediate players are very welcome at the Regional. Bridge University will be held on Monday with four educational sessions and a 0 - 199 game in the afternoon. For Tuesday through Friday, there will be I/N games every day at 10:00AM and 3:00PM if there are enough people for 3 full tables. In addition, there will be an educational session 45 minutes before the afternoon game.
