#### **Dear Mark:**

The ACBL Grand National Teams (GNT) contest begins with each of the ACBL's 25 districts selecting teams to represent them at the national GNT competition at the summer North American Bridge Championship (NABC). The District Six GNT finals Open Flight starts on 1/7/2023 and Flights A, B, and C each start



on 2/4/2023. The exact start times of the events are still TBD. This year the Open competition will be inperson while the Flight A, B, and C competitions will be held on BBO. Teams are not required to qualify at a club before entering the district competition. Pre-registration is due about 10 days before the start date. Please visit the <u>District 6 Bridge</u> web site for registration details and the complete schedule for each flight.

## **Bidding Contests:**

- Several of us have tried the interactive <u>ACBL Bidding Contest</u>, it is very nice! Every week on Monday five hands will appear automatically in the app on your (and your partner's) phone or tablet. You bid these hands with your partner, turn by turn. After the bidding is over (sometimes Opps interfere), you get a score from 0-10. The scoring is imps. You have until Sunday midnight to finish the bidding. Shortly afterwards you will get a detailed score report email that includes showing how an expert pair bid each hand and your weekly ranking. This bidding contest is free for ACBL members! The other aspects of the app (which look pretty good!) require a low-cost subscription.
