The <u>NVBA Winter Sectional</u> starts up this week! Join us for four days of face-to-face bridge right in our backyard! Play starts Thursday 2/16 and continues through Sunday 2/19. The opening night session will be in-person Thursday Night Unit Games at both the NVBA and the WBL locations. The combined



table counts are used to determine overall masterpoints for that night. Let's bring back the "old" prepandemic excitement of competing at your favorite location for lots of silver points! See <u>Winter Sectional</u> <u>Flyer</u> for the full schedule and policies. In particular, please note we are CASHLESS: Be sure to have a credit card with you to pay for entries and food. Even better, use the <u>ACBL Entry Express</u> to sign-up for a game beforehand. Encourage your ACBL friends with fewer than 5 ACBL masterpoints to play: They can receive a free play (no game fee) at any Sectional game!

NVBA Winter Sectional - Entry Express Instructions:

- Entry Express provides the ability for ACBL members to purchase their entries for any NVBA Winter Sectional game in advance and save time when arriving at the playing site.
- Clink on the link <u>NVBA Winter Sectional Entry Express</u>. If you see your name in the upper right-hand corner, you are ready to purchase. If not, click on the login button and login into the ACBL web site.
- Once logged in, you select any session of the Sectional and purchase an entry. The cost will be \$14 per player per session.
- After completing your purchase, you will receive a confirmation email with instructions about what to do once you arrive at the site to play.
- When using **Entry Express**, you must buy your entry no later than 11:59 pm on the day before the session is played.
- Please do not use **Entry Express** if you are applying for a discount, such as Juniors and players with less than 5 masterpoints.
- See <u>Entry Express Help</u> if you have any other questions.

Thursday Night Unit Games:
