### This week - Thursday, 3/23:

There will be A/X Pairs (unlimited/4000), B/C/D Pairs (2500/1500/750), and 199er Pairs (200/100/50) games as long as the three-table minimum required for a section to run is met. All games start promptly at 7:00pm.

# **NVBA Spring Sectional - Entry Express:**

- Entry Express provides the ability for ACBL members to purchase their entries for any NVBA Spring Sectional game in advance and save time when arriving at the playing site.
- Clink on the link <u>NVBA Spring Sectional Entry Express</u>. If you see your name in the upper right-hand corner, you are ready to purchase. If not, click on the login button and login into the ACBL web site.
- Once logged in, you select any session of the Sectional and purchase an entry. The cost will be \$14 per player per session that you purchase, with all events on Saturday costing \$15 per player per session for the regionally rated masterpoints and support of the District 6 Grass Roots events.
- After completing your purchase, you will receive a confirmation email with instructions about what to do once you arrive at the site to play.
- When using **Entry Express**, you must buy your entry no later than 11:59 pm on the day before the session is played.
- Please do not use **Entry Express** if you are applying for a discount, such as Juniors and players with less than 5 masterpoints.
