Subject: NVBA E-News - NVBA Winter Sectional is this Thursday 2/15 to Sunday 2/18!

### **Dear Mark:**

The NVBA will hold its first sectional of the year, the <u>NVBA Winter Sectional</u>, from February 15 - 18. This is an opportunity to see your friends and to play competitive bridge in a socially fun environment!



**Thursday Evening**: The kick-off session will be held Thursday evening February 15 at both Unit Game sites, continuing our tradition of competing in your favorite location for lots of silver points, since combined table counts are used to determine overall masterpoints for that night.

The tournament will continue at the nicely renovated main hall of the Arlington/Fairfax Elks Lodge Friday-Sunday:

**Friday Afternoon & Evening**: Three stratified pairs events Friday afternoon (Open (A/X), 0-2500 (B/C/D), and 499ers) and the Triple Nickel Swiss and a 0-750 pairs game on Friday night.

**Saturday Morning & Afternoon**: Saturday offers lots of extra silver points at both sessions. In the morning, we begin our annual two-session <u>barometer</u> final Open Pairs event plus a one-session <u>stratified pairs</u> game for B/C/D (0-3000) players. In the afternoon, there will be a Stratified Consolation Pairs for those who do not qualify for the <u>Barometer</u> Final plus all other players who want to play a one-session game. For \$1 more each session, all events that day will be regionally rated, with the extra income going to <u>District 6</u> to help support our players who win our District <u>NAP</u> and <u>GNT</u> competitions and represent us at the national level in these events.

**Sunday Morning & Afternoon**: The tournament concludes with Flight A <u>Swiss</u> and <u>Bracketed</u> B (0-3000) Teams on Sunday the 18th. plus the **New! You asked for it! Stratified 499er Pairs Sunday morning**.

**0-750 players**, we have special events just for YOU at the sectional! There will be a free Intermediate/Newcomer Lecture by NVBA Master Teacher Ron Kral on Friday at 1:30PM (What Does that Double Mean?) and another again on Saturday at 2:30PM (When to Bid One More?). Use your new knowledge to play in Saturday morning's one-session Stratified Pairs game for B/C/D players and Sunday's two-session Bracketed B Teams.

**49er/199er/499er players**, we welcome you to the Sectional as well. You can learn from Master Teacher Ron Kral Friday (1:30PM) and Saturday (2:30PM) and compete against your peers and more experienced players in **Thursday** Evening's B/C/D Pairs (Strat D's upper limit is 750); **Friday** afternoon's stratified 100/300/500 (499er Pairs), and Friday evening's 200/500/750 Pairs. Saturday's morning and afternoon 0-750 Pairs have the same strats as Friday evening, and **Sunday morning's 499er Pairs** has the same strats as Friday afternoon. You always have the opportunity to kibitz top local players who include many National and World Champion players -- just ask a Director who you should watch.
