 - There are often voice or chat commentators that add nice insight to the play. Hope you watch when Mark Chen from NVBA and Brad Theurer from WBL are the video commentators.
 - The default view is to kibitz all four hands. If you want to kibitz a certain player, move the cursor over North/South/East/West and hit the right mouse button.
 - Click on the player's name to see that player's profile and convention card. There are lots of interesting world-class bidding and carding methods there!
