

**Forty-third Annual Meeting of the Northern Virginia Bridge Association
(draft minutes)**

May 12, 2005

President Leo Cardillo welcomed everyone to the 43rd annual meeting of the Northern Virginia Bridge Association and the eighth Annual Pat Eyman Memorial Strawberry Pairs, and called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

President's Comments:

1. Good evening and welcome to the 43rd Annual Meeting and elections of the NVBA. In addition, tonight we will celebrate the eighth annual "Pat Eyman Strawberry Pairs", in memory of Pat , a multi-term member, VP and President of the NVBA. The meeting is called to order.
2. The first order of business is to ask for a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the annual meeting of 2004. Carolyn Gibson so moved. Stan Schenker seconded. The motion carried.
3. The NVBA Policies and Procedures require an annual financial statement be presented to the members at the annual meeting. NVBA Treasurer Diane Alexander will now present that statement.

Diane reported that the Unit put some money this past year into building attendance and publishing a new Directory, so the year-end amount of cash on hand was slightly less than in 2003. Overall, she said the Unit is in good financial condition and copies of the annual financial statement are available for anyone interested in reading it.

President's comments continue:

4. As my second year as President comes to a close, I am pleased to note that the NVBA is in good shape. The goals that I proposed after my election are still in effect:
 1. Increase the quality and quantity of bridge for our NVBA members
 2. Balance the Unit Budget
 3. Cooperate closely with the WBL
 4. Support the District, MABC and the ACBL.
 - * Progress has been realized on each of these goals, but there is more work to be done.
 - * Attendance at the Unit game has been maintained, and, at the same time, a Novice or 199er game has been firmly established. The Novice game has been averaging ten tables during recent weeks, and that is excellent! Ron Kral, John Mason, Gene Schuyler, and other members of the "Novice Mafia" deserve special recognition for their efforts in establishing the Novice game.
 - * NVBA Membership has remained relatively constant at 1,500 members, but with the help of David Banh, the Youth Advisor to the Board, about 15 new ACBL members have been recruited from the students of TJHSST, and that is an important step that is vital to the future of the Unit

and the game of bridge. In that vein, I have completed my fourth academic year at TJHSST as the Bridge Advisor to the Bridge Club (BC). Attendance at the BC averages in excess of ten tables every Friday, and that number of young players also bodes well for the future of the game. Even so, average age in the Unit is 61.85 years, and that is the lowest in the entire District!

* An online Directory has been developed with the help of Scott Merritt, Lucy McCoy, Doug Grove, Ron Kral and others. The online Directory will allow our members to have up-to-date information on all the NVBA members.

* Stan Schenker has done a terrific job in providing caddies through-out the year and established an email system that seems to meet all contingencies.

* The hands that we will play tonight were pre-duped by use of the WBL system. Don't ask the Board about my position on pre-dupes!

* Cooperation with the WBL and the District, MABC and ACBL occurs as a regular part of NVBA business. Looking ahead,

* Diane has mentioned the deficit for this year and that area requires further attention. Over the past seven years, the NVBA has operated at a slight profit (about \$200 per year on average), but I want to continue efforts to stabilize the Unit finances and realize a small, but steady profit each year.

* The LM/NLM game is 19 May - Ron Kral made an announcement asking players to sign up.

* The Bridge Information Line (BIL) is under construction and Sam and Dell Coleman will maintain this capability.
