Last week's unit game had 11.5 tables. Congratulations to winners Alan Schwartz - Annie Schwartz (NS) and Martha Bley - Ross Bley (EW). Full results here. This week's game will be a North American Pairs qualifier, with a separate 99er section if attendance permits. This week and for the



remainder of August, the pre-game lesson will be a question and answer session. Please bring your bridge-related questions: a hand you had trouble with, a bridge term you've heard that you'd like explained, a question about bidding or play or scoring or how tournaments work, or anything else.

The regional in Hanover MD (formerly held in Baltimore) starts next week. Details are in the tournament flyer. There will be a full schedule of events for players of all levels, including a special game on Tuesday, August 19, just for players with fewer than 100 masterpoints (players with 0-20 masterpoints play FREE that day!). Hotel rooms are still available if you are interested in staying at the site overnight.
